Courses

MTFS Learn IT

- Basic Digital Literacy (In Person): Provides essential computer skills, software skills, and tips for using technology in daily life.
 - Computer Essentials: Includes modules on basic computer skills, Windows 10, basic Internet skills, and using email.
 - Microsoft Office Essentials: Includes modules on Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
- CompTIA IT Fundamentals+ Certification (Instructor Led Virtual or Self Paced): Provides students with a solid foundation in IT skills and prepares students for the CompTIA IT Fundamentals+ certification exam.
- CompTIA A+ Certification (Instructor Led Virtual or Self Paced): Become a certified IT technician. Covers hardware, software, networking, and security.
- CompTIA Project+ Certification (In Person): Provides students with foundational project management skills. Covers essential project management concepts beyond the scope of just one methodology or framework.
- CompTIA Network+ Certification (Self Paced): Become a certified network technician. Covers network design, implementation, and troubleshooting.
- CompTIA Security+ Certification (Self Paced): Become a certified security professional. Covers network security, threat management, and cryptography.

- HTML5 | CSS Fundamentals (In Person): Teaches tools to develop websites and web-apps. Each student will build a website in this class.
- JavaScript (In Person): Learn the basics of JavaScript, from data types to conditional statements. Receive a certificate of completion and leave with two simple projects that demonstrate beginning knowledge.
